- Continued importance of media engagement to raise awareness of issues
- The launch of the V11 Foundation
- Concerns about the deregulatory agenda
- Survey to gauge what issues stakeholders want the APPG to deal with
- The need to increase frequency of secretariat and APPG meetings
- The Hillsborough Law; relevant Financial Services bodies should be brought into scope
